FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

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Weather permitting, on Monday April 11, 2011, the City of Port Huron will begin construction on the 21st Street Area Phase II project. The work includes sewer separation, water main replacement and paving within the area bounded by Griswold Street to Court Street and 16th Street to 24th Street. This project is possible because the City has received a federal grant through the U.S. EPA.

This will be a two year project with work scheduled to begin the week of April 11, 2011 and last through November 2012. By the end of November this year all streets that had undergone construction during 2011 will be completed through the first layer of asphalt. The top layers of asphalt will be withheld from being placed until the summer of 2012. Sewer installations in alleys are tentatively scheduled to occur this year and wrap up December 28th, 2011.

Due to construction, streets within the project area will be closed to thru traffic at various times. We encourage the public to use alternate routes.
