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The City of Port Huron will mail the 2017 summer tax bills on Thursday, June 29, 2017. The summer taxes may be paid without penalty on or before July 31, 2017.

Tax rate per \$1,000 of Taxable Value is as follows:

The Port Huron Area School District has also levied an additional 18.00 mills on all non-principle residence property. The Downtown Development Authority has also levied an additional 1.9874 mills on all property located within said district.

The City Treasurer's Office has available the necessary forms for a person whose household income does not exceed \$40,000 and who qualifies by being over 62 years of age, a paraplegic, quadriplegic, a person totally and permanently disabled, a blind person or an eligible serviceperson, eligible veteran, eligible widow or widower, to defer the payment of their 2017 summer tax bill until February 15, 2018. These forms must be completed by September 15, 2017.

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
