

Other important items

- All RV's or OHRV's shall be locked or secured at all times when not in use
- Only fitted covers shall be used, except covers shall not be used over a motorhome or travel trailer parked in the front driveway from May 1 to October 31.
- RV's parked or stored on property shall not be used for living, lodging, or housekeeping purposes.
- RV's or OHRV's must be kept in good condition and have a current year's license & registration in the name of a member of the immediate family of the property owner or tenant.

Recreational Vehicle Parking Requirements

Enclosed are the City of Port Huron Zoning regulations for parking or storage of recreational vehicle and off-highway recreational vehicles.



During the winter months, RV's and OHRV's cannot be parked in the driveway in the front yard. They can only be parked in the rear yard or side yard behind the house. Please find alternative storage before November 1st to avoid any tickets or fines.

What is an RV or OHRV?

- An RV is a recreational vehicle that shall be defined as a boat, camper, travel trailer, motorhome, or similar recreational vehicle.
- An OHRV is an off-highway recreational vehicle that shall be defined as a jet ski, four-wheeler, snowmobile or similar off-highway recreational vehicle.

Where to park an RV or OHRV?

- Cannot be parked on a vacant lot.
- Only one RV or two OHRV's may be parked on the lot at any given time.
- May be parked in an approved parking area on the premises for loading or unloading purposes for a period not to exceed 48 hours.
- **Winter, November 1 to April 30** – May be parked only in the rear or side yard, 3' from the property line, on a residential lot. Cannot be parked in front of a neighboring house if house is adjacent to the rear yard.
- **Summer, May 1 to October 31** – In addition to the rear and side yard, may also be parked in the front yard in a paved driveway in front of a garage or a paved parking pad to the side of the driveway. May not be parked in front of the front door or windows of a house.
- Can never be parked in the street right-of-way between the property line and the curb
- Watercraft may be parked on the beach all year, provided they are parked in the sand or over the water
